Report from County Councillor Titley

County Councillor Titley reported that discussions were taking place with the Aviva bus company to try to persuade it to make a regular stop in Longdon Village. There is a County Council design team working to implement a traffic calming scheme for Upper Longdon and work should begin soon.

Support for Parish Council Activities

The Highways and Open Spaces Committee was pleased to announce that Mrs Irene Kemp has volunteered to monitor the condition of the Parish's footpaths. Additionally, Mrs Gladys Crowe and Mrs Pauline Furniss have volunteered to become litter pickers across the Parish. The Council passed a vote of thanks to all three volunteers for their help in the upkeep of our Parish.

Church Hill, Longdon Green

It was noted that Church Hill residents had expressed their thanks for the work the Parish Council has funded to clean-up the verges and footpaths on Church Hill.

Annual Parish Assembly

This will be held on Tuesday 28th April at 19.30 at St James School, Longdon. We hope that parishioners will attend the meeting to hear what the Parish Council is planning for the future and to contribute with comments and questions.

Council Precept

The Parish Council receives a sum of money every year from Lichfield District Council. This funding (or precept) supports activities carried out through the year. It is, of course, tax payers' money. The Parish Council has decided that it will not seek an increase in the precept for next year and it will hold spending at last year's level. We hope that our Parishioners will see this as a responsible approach to public money.
