## **Longdon Memorial Hall.**

Concerns were brought by the public about the lack of information regarding the future of the Memorial Hall land and building. In the first instance the Parish Council has been making enquiries including contacting 'Longdon Club & Institute'. The Parish Council now advises that in regard to 'the Club', the Club secretary, via email, has requested that all enquiries should be made direct to her. Here is the email for general information:
