Memorial Hall and Longdon Club

Club, the land owned by the Club, and the Memorial Hall. The Parish Council agreed to approach the Club again and seek a meeting.

Rugeley Farm Fire

There was concern among councillors at smoke which was coming from a burning pile of refuse at Oak Tree Farm, Rugeley. The smoke had been drifting over parts of Upper Longdon and settling.

Staffs County Council and fire service are looking at this. SCC Cllr Tittley highlighted the environmental issues to deal with this fire as a natural aquifer lay under the site. Cllrs expressed concern that the lorries which were turning up to tip, could possible move to fly tip elsewhere in the area. SCC have confirmed that the smoke is not toxic.

New times for Council Meetings

The Parish Council agreed that in order to reduce confusion, **ALL** the monthly full parish council meetings will now start at **7pm**. The next meeting will be 8th November 2016 in WI Hall, Longdon.
