Highways and Open Spaces Committee

Lichfield District Council had written to the parish council concerning the future ownership of land opposite Gentleshaw School. The corner of land is currently mown and maintained by the parish council. Lichfield District Council are keen that the PC take ownership of the site. Talks will take place on this.

Election Recharges

The parish council had been invoiced by Lichfield District Council, for their share of the costs associated with the elections held in May 2015. It would appear that Staffordshire County Council and Lichfield District Council will now apportion all

election costs held in the area and the parish council will need to pay.



Speeding

A couple of local residents in Upper Longdon had been in touch regarding the speed and weight of traffic passing through the village. The parish council were informed that Phase 2 of the Upper Longdon Speed restrictions could not take place until after the May County Council elections. In the meantime, radar checks on traffic speed had been undertaken at Bradley Lakes and in Upper Longdon. The Bradley Lakes information is already available on the parish council website and the Upper Longdon results will be placed on there as soon as they are received.



Councillor Vacancy

The Parish Council sadly received the resignation of Cllr Norman Stanfield. Thanks were given to his hard work and commitment to the parish council. The vacancy would be declared to the district council and the vacancy advertised in accordance with practice. Should anyone be interested in applying for the post, please contact the clerk.
