Walks in Longdon Parish

One of the items on the website is a description of local walks around our lovely countryside. It was proposed that over the coming months, these walks would be highlighted using this Newsletter. Leaflets of the walks can be found in and around the parish including at Longdon post office, the local pubs and in the bus stop at Longdon Green.

Walk 1 Longdon Way: This route takes a circular route to the south east of the village, mainly across open farmland with some sections along country roads. Gentle elevation. It is 4km / 2.5miles long.

The walk starts at the Swan with Two Necks in Longdon, passes St James the

Great Church and up to the triangulation pillar which affords great views over the vale of the River Trent to the distant Peak District. Pass along the ridge and then



down into Longdon Green. The walk then splits into a longer walk or shortened walk avoiding fields. The walk then returns back to Longdon past the Memorial Hall and back to the start.
