Councillors agreed to amend the terms and conditions for the parish council

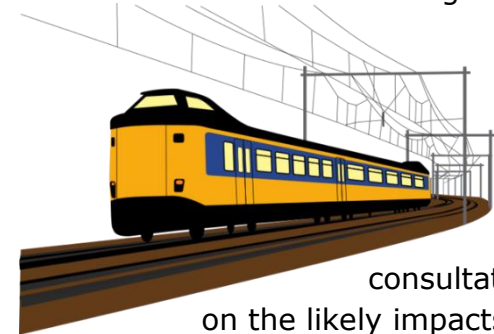


grants to enable applications all year round rather than only 3 times a year. For more information on how to apply and eligibility, please visit our website.

HS2 Consultation

Correspondence has been received from the Stakeholder Engagement Manager for HS2 Phase 2a. They are coming to the September parish council meeting, providing an opportunity to discuss the potential impacts of the construction of

Phase 2a of HS2. (Phase 2a is the section of new high-speed railway connecting the West Midlands and Crewe.) Between September and November 2017 they are holding



consultations on the likely impacts of Phase 2a, and on some of the changes proposed to the plans that were announced in November 2015.
