### **Improvements at Longdon Green**

The Parish Council agreed to buy and get installed a new village name sign to replace the broken one on Church Way. In addition, a new dog bin will be bought and located by the bus shelter in Longdon Green. It was also agreed that new flower tubs would be bought and sited in the village once local residents willing to care and maintain them had been found. Anyone interested in



caring for new flower tubs should contact the parish clerk.

### **Councillor Vacancy on the Parish Council**

Owing to the resignation of Cllr Kemp from the Parish Council, there was a now a vacancy for a co-opted councillor at Longdon ward. The notice advising of this vacancy will be posted. Anyone wishing to apply should visit the parish council website and look at most frequently used documents in order to get an application form.

### **Tree Work planned at Berkeley Way**

Following a detailed tree survey of the parish council owned land at Berkeley Way, quotes are being sought for work to make a number of the trees safer and healthy. Please take care when walking in this area during the tree works.
